ACT

ON AMENDMENTS TO THE ACT ON LINER SHIPPING AND SEASONAL COASTAL MARITIME TRANSPORT

Article 1

In the Act on Liner Shipping and Seasonal Coastal Maritime Transport ("Official Gazette", No. 33/06), in Article 8 paragraph 2, Article 10 paragraph 2, Article 17 paragraph 2, Article 26 paragraphs 3 and 5, Article 30 paragraph 2 point 2 and Article 64 paragraph 3, the words: "county government" are replaced with the words: "county assembly", in the corresponding gender and case.

Article 2

In Article 9 paragraph 2, Article 10 paragraph 2, Article 17 paragraph 2, Article 26 paragraph 3, Article 30 paragraph 2 point 3 and Article 64 paragraph 3, the words: "municipal or city/town government" are replaced with the words "municipal or city/town council", in the corresponding gender and case.

Article 3

This Act shall be published in the Official Gazette, and shall enter into force on the effective date of the decision on the scheduling of the next general and regular elections of representatives in the municipality and town councils, county assemblies and the Zagreb City Assembly, as well as of municipality mayors, mayors, county prefects and the Mayor of the City of Zagreb, while the present municipality, city and county governments shall continue with their operation until the municipality mayors, mayors and county prefects elected in direct elections assume office.
